

Procedure for conduction of Certificate Course (CC) for A.Y 2020-21

Certificate Course/Skill Oriented Course is intended to acquire expertise in the gained academic knowledge added with available development tools in order to enrich their professional and holistic development.

It is a mandatory and non-credited course offered by the departments of College to cater to the required proficiency necessarily to be gained by a student.

A student is eligible for the award of degree after their successful completion of specified number of Certificate Courses during their period of study from a set of Certificate Courses offered by the College, as per the Academic Regulations approved by BOS.

The right of offering a particular Certificate Course in a semester is only at the discretion of College authorities.

Registration for certificate course:

A student either newly admitted or on rolls have to register for a Certificate Course at their parent department, on the day of registration in respective semester only.

Attendance and Detention policy:

All attendance considerations and detentions shall be done as per the Academic Regulations of the student.

There shall be no condonation in case of student obtained attendance less than 75% and greater than 65%, instead she/he will be detained.

Evaluation of Certificate Courses

A student's academic progress is examined through one examination in their In Semester Evaluation (ISE) and another examination in Semester End Evaluation (SEE) according to any one or combination of the appropriate method from the following methods as decided by the Certificate Course Coordinator

- Quizzes
- Objective type questions
- Projects
- Apps development
- Essay type examination, etc.,

The distribution of evaluation weightage will be decided and announced by the Course Coordinator at the beginning of the course.

Evaluation weightages and other necessary modalities are to be followed as per the Academic Regulations of the student only.
