The meeting began with the welcome address by the Principal, Chairman, Academic Council, Sasi Institute of Tech & Engg. He introduced all the members to the council and asked the member Secretary to proceed further. Based on agenda, the following resolutions have been taken in the third academic council.

All the Council members of the meeting reviewed the implementation of resolutions made in the 2nd Academic Council and expressed satisfactory.

Item 1: Approval of Syllabus and Electives of IV year of SITE18 regulations.

- * The member Secretary has explained about the syllabus of IV B.Tech SITE2018 regulations and how professional electives and open electives chosen for each course.
- * Dr. C. Prabhakar Reddy, Dean, School of Engineering & Tech, CMR University, suggested in the 8th Sem keep more electives in the syllabus, so that even student got the job in 7th sem, we can relieve him early by doing his internship and in parallel he can complete the subjects through swayam, moocs, Coursera etc.
- * Dr G. Seshikala, Professor, School of multidisciplinary - Bio Engineering, REVA University opined that any project

based program/ skill development program in every year will improve the confidence and maturity of the student to handle the projects by his own. Also suggested to include multi-discipline subjects for each course, so that they can be in better position to get a job.

* Dr R Srinivasa Rao, Director, Academic planning, JNTUK University, opined if the regulation strictly follow AICTE/ Govt of Andhra Pradesh guidelines, there is no problem with the syllabus.

* Dr K Bhanu Prasad, Principal, Chairman agreed the points raised by the expert members and promised to consider all the suggestions in the SITE18 regulations.

Resolution: All the members have approved the syllabus of IV B.Tech SITE18 regulations.

Item2: Approval of Syllabi for I & II year ECT and CST courses of SITE18 regulations.

* The member Secretary has explained about the syllabi of I & II B.Tech ECT and CST courses of SITE18 regulations and also elucidated why ECT & CST courses follow the same syllabus of ECE and CSF courses.

* Dr H M Rajasekhar Swamy, HoD, CIVIL Engineering, M S Ramaiah University opined that, if department of ECE follows offers two branches ECE and ECT there is no issue. Even AICTE has advised to form new courses as per current industrial needs.

* Dr K Bhanu Prasad, Principal, chairman informed to the expert members that we retained the Syllabus same for ECT and CST for the first two years. For III & IV year there is definitely a change in the Syllabus structure. In the next 6 months, we finalize the Syllabi of III & IV year and be placed in agenda for the discussion in the next Council meeting.

Resolution: All the members have approved the Syllabi of I & II B.Tech CST and ECT SITE18 regulations.

Item 3: Review and Approval of the results for B.Tech, M.Tech and MBA (2018-19 & 2019-20 admitted)

* The member secretary has shown the statistics of B.Tech, M.Tech and MBA Regular/ Supplementary results of SITE18 regulations shown in the table.

* Dr C Prabhakar Reddy, Dean, School of Engg & Tech, CMR University, opined, in the I year the results are poor for the subjects Mathematics, Basic Electrical Engineering & Chemistry, particularly for ME & CE branches. He advised to put extra effort in the labs so that the failure rate will come down.

* Dr L Sumalatha, Director of Evaluation, JNTUK University, agreed with Dr. Prabhakar Reddy observation and suggested, to improve the pass percentage, need to incorporate more remedial classes for ME and CE students because the students taking admission in these branches have low academic background.

* Dr. H M Rajsekhar Swamy, HoD, Civil Engg, MS Ramaiah University agreed with Dr. L Sumalatha opinion that ME and CE students are scoring bit less compared to other branches.

* Dr. R. Srinivasa Rao, Director, Academic Planning, JNTUK University, reviewed the results of MBA all semesters and mentioned in some subjects the internal & external marks obtained by the student is close even though there is a difference in internal (40) & External (60) marks.

- * Dr K Bhavu Prasad, Principal, Chairman agreed the points raised by the expert members and promised to consider all the suggestions given by the expert members.

Resolution: All the members have unanimously approved the above mentioned merit of B.Tech, M.Tech and MBA Regular and Supplementary of SITE 2018 regulations.

Item 4: Review and Discuss the direct promotion of Students to higher classes in the A.Y. 2020-21

- * The member Secretary moved a point "Direct promotion of Students to higher classes in the A.Y. 2020-21 due to Covid pandemic" for discussion.
- * Dr P V Subbaiah, HoD ECE & Controller of Examinations, VR Siddhartha Engg College, opined that the AICTE also given guidelines to permit the Students to higher classes in the A.Y. 2020-21 without considering the credits.
- * Dr H M Rajsekhar Swamy, HoD, Civil Engineering, MS Ramaiah University asked the member Secretary, whether they are conducting external exams offline or by taking the average of previous Semester results for the Students to promote to higher classes. Dr. R. Srinivasa Rao said the JNTUK directed all the affiliated institutes to conduct the exams offline.
- * Dr K Bhavu Prasad, principal informed to the expert members that we conducted all practical & theory regular/Supplementary exams in offline mode.

Resolution: All the members have agreed and approved to promote the Students to higher classes.

Item 5: Review, discuss and modify the Condition for Promotion to higher classes. for SITE18 regulations.

- * The member Secretary has explained the existing promotion rule and asked the members to review and approve the new amendment for promotion.

Existing promotion policy

- * Student admitted to 5th Sem should clear all the 1st Sem subjects.
- * Student admitted to 6th Sem should clear all the 2nd Sem subjects.
- * Student admitted to 7th Sem should clear all the 3rd Sem subjects.
- * Student admitted to 8th Sem should clear all the 4th Sem subjects.

New Amendment for promotion.















- * Student admitted to 5th Sem, if he fulfills the academic requirement of 40% of the credits upto 4th Sem from all the examinations.

* Dr V Raveendranath, OSD to Honorable vice-chancellor & PRO, JNTUK University, reviewed the new amendment and asked the member Secretary about any internal cut-off marks for passing the subject. Dr. K. Bhano pointed cleared that it is not placed in SITE18 regulations.
